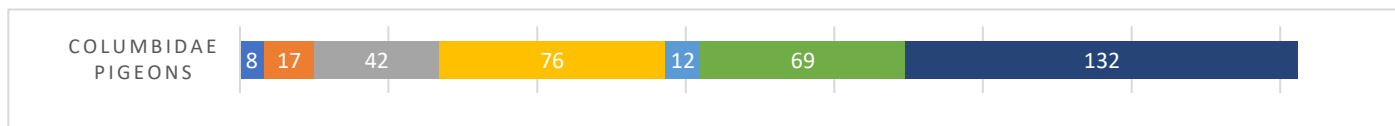
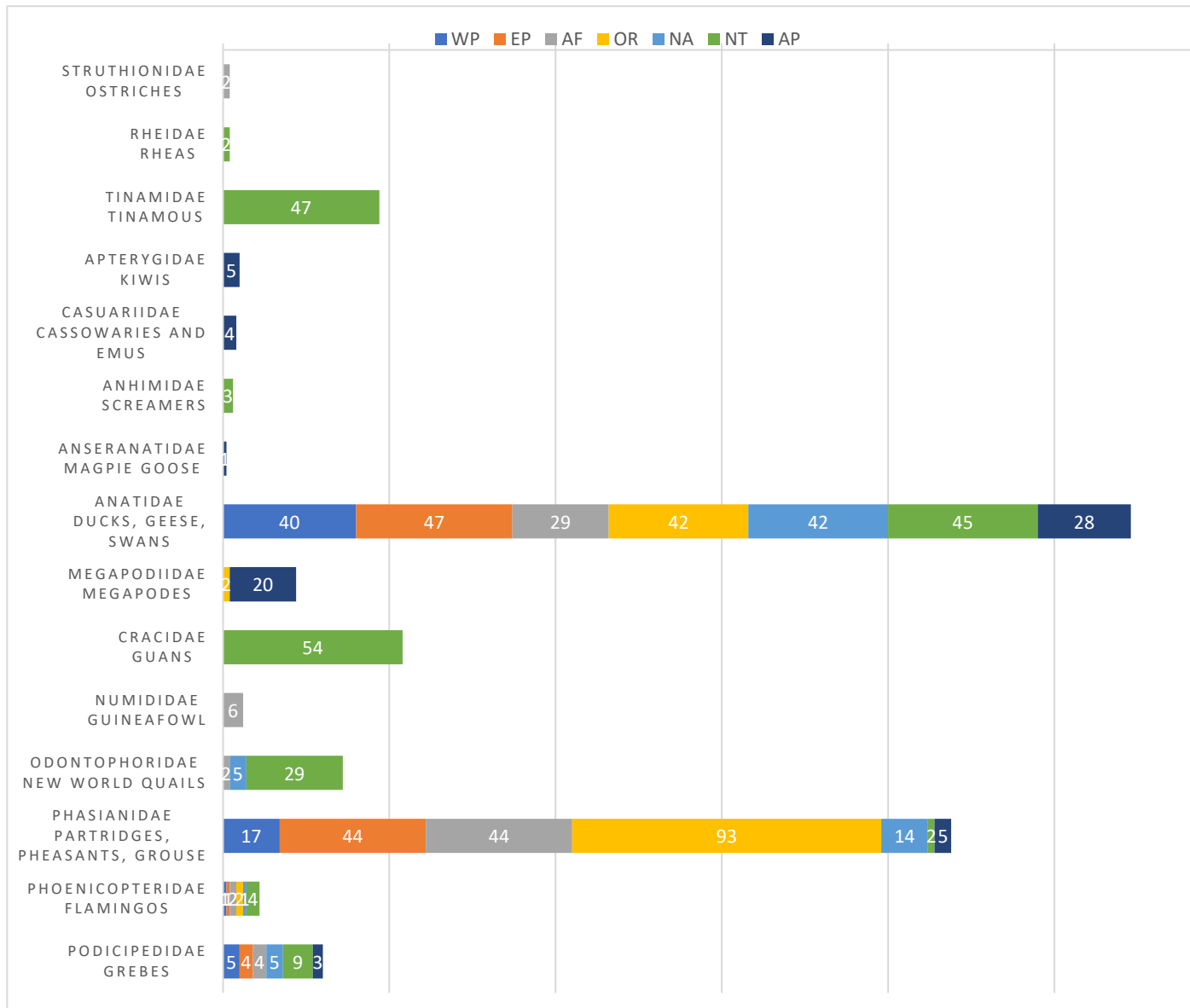
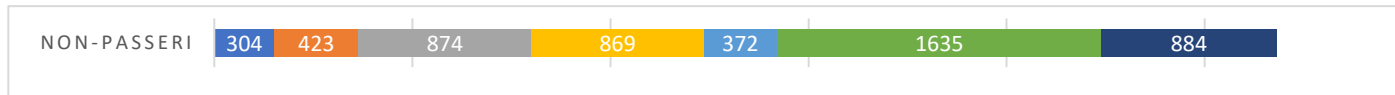
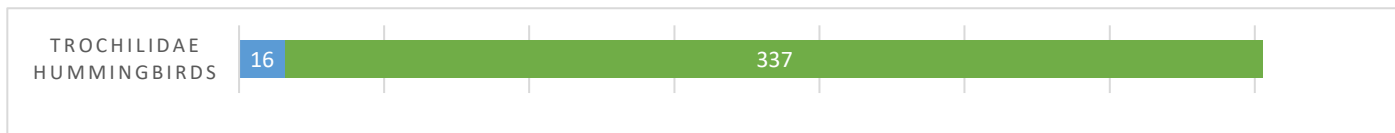
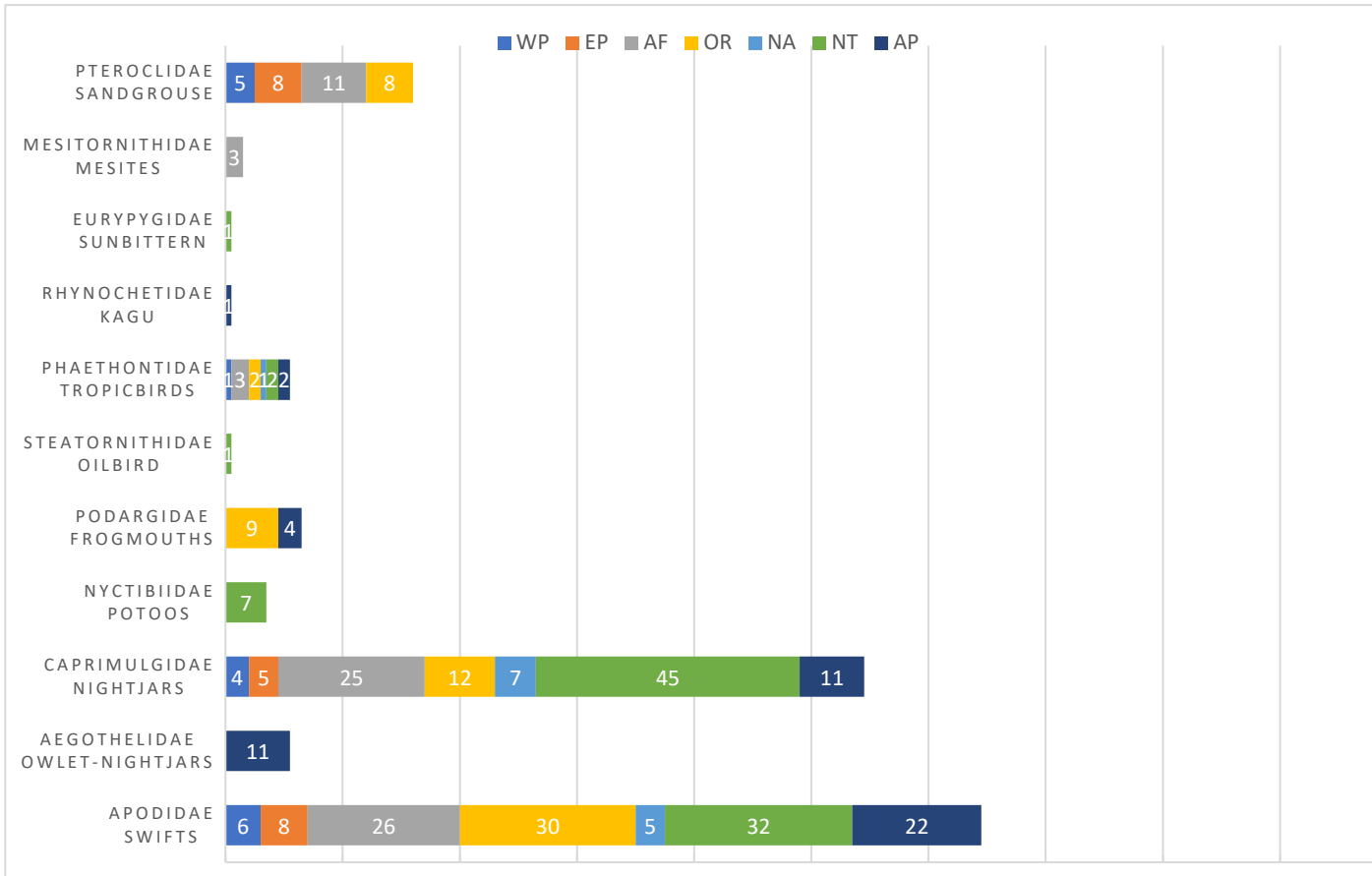
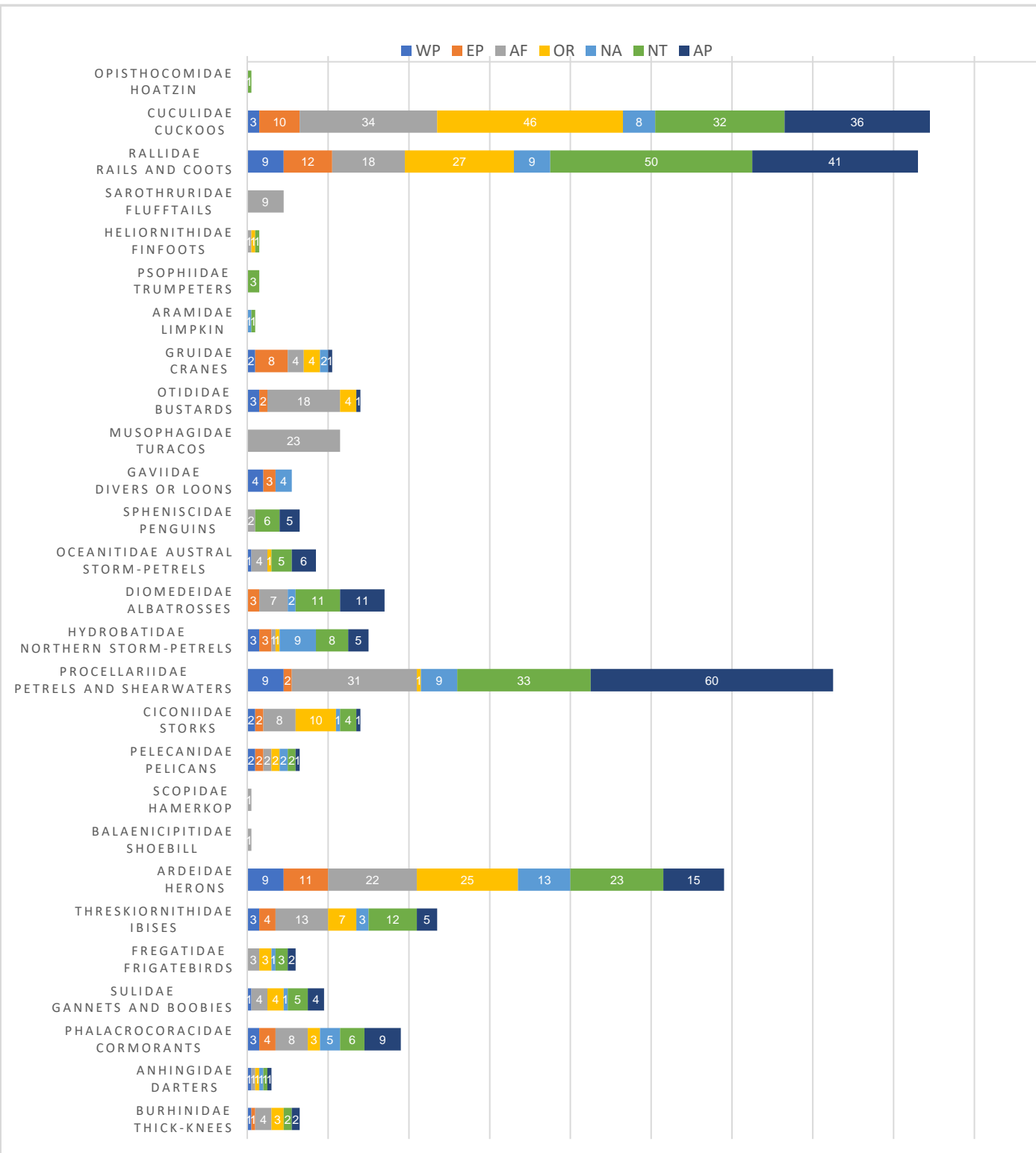


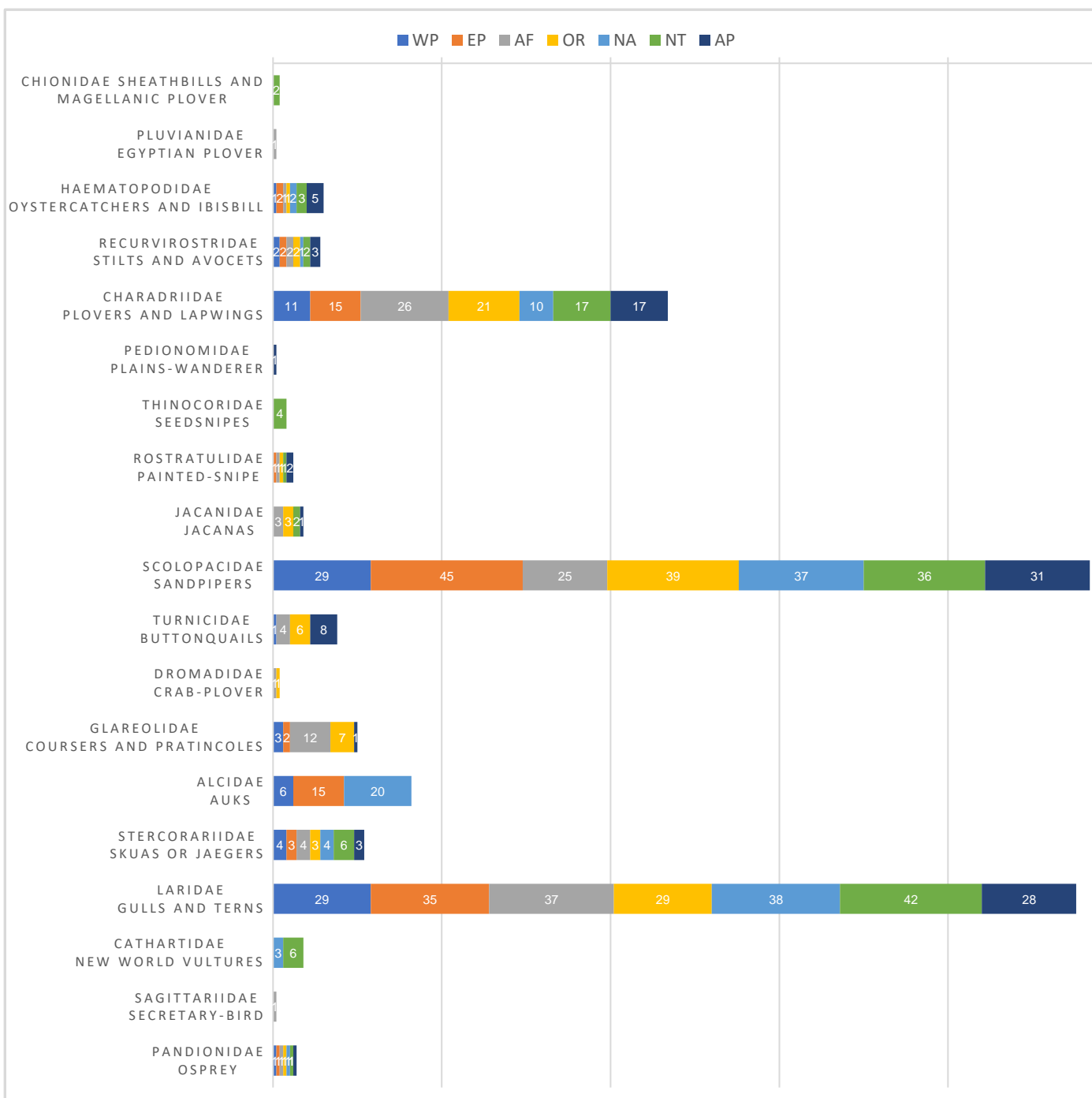
Following are the number of non-Passerines species by biogeographical area (the same species naturally occur in multiple regions)
